Duluth Federal Prison- a) NTACT PERSON- Volunteer Coordinator Tonya Gajeski 218-249-7389.

Chaplin also involved with AA work in the prison. Roughly 670 inmates in the prison. Need to have training by the prison to participate in AA Meetings. The training is usually in the springtime. Must have background check to go into the faciLity. Meetings are at 6:00 pm. They are short on staff which might interfere with meetings. In the past they wanted a letter from AA to verify that an AA member that wiLL be attending the AA meeting has enough sobriety and knows the AA principles. AA members attending the meeting are recommended to have 3 months to one year sobriety, have a background check and not be on probation.
